

**COVID-19 UPDATE - Amenities, Services and Activities**  
**Updated on July 11, 2020**

**Health and Safety** We are fully compliant and will remain so with the directions provided by government health authorities.

**Social Distancing** We ask that all guests *not within their 'safe social circle'* maintain a social distancing of at least 2 meters and that parents maintain full supervision of their children.

**Check in** All transactions (check-ins, documents, waivers, etc.) can be done electronically and in advance of check-in, in order to maintain social distancing measures. Assistance will be made available for those that are unable to or have difficulty submitting documents electronically.

**Store** Safe contact-free shopping is available. Store will be open from 10:00am to 7:00pm. Firewood, ice and some light grocery will be available for sale. Vending machine with cold drinks will be available as well, with regular full sanitization by our staff.

**Bathroom & Showers** We just finished renovation of the washroom. The toilets and showers are now brand new and open.

**Laundry Room** The laundry room will be open from 10:00am to 7:00pm but limited to one household at any time. Please pick up the key at the contact free store. Regular full sanitization will be done by our staff.

**Playground** The playground is open with sanitization protocol followed. Playground users should avoid large groups and gatherings and be at least two metres away from people from another household or their safe social circle. People should wash their hands before and after using the equipment, cover all coughs and sneezes and avoid touching their face.

**Trail** remains open with social distancing rule in effect.

**Recreational RV's** We are currently accepting RV's.

**Snowbirds and Full-Time RV'ers** We are currently accommodating returning Snowbirds and full-time RV'ers.

**Tent Camping** We are accepting tent campings.

**Day-Visitors** We are sorry that we will not accept day-visitors; Registered guests only.

**Activities** We will not be able to have our special events this year due to the restrictions of group sizes. We might be able to show outdoor movies if the situation allows. Together we can still have a fun and safe camping season.

## **Guest COVID-19 Code of Conduct** **Updated on June 22, 2020**

You and your party agree to obey this Code of Conduct while at our Campground and RV Park.

### **Group**

Each group in an RV site must be from one household unit, or “within their safe social circle”.

### **Households**

Households are defined as those people that live in one home and have maintained social distancing with others during the Covid-19 outbreak.

### **Hand Washing**

Wash hands for at least 20 seconds in warm water and soap every time you enter or exit your unit.

### **Social Distancing**

You and your party must always maintain 2-metre (6 feet) separation from anyone else when at our site, and during outings. No gatherings of more than 10 people in a unit are allowed at any time.

If you come across someone not maintaining the 2-metre (6 feet) social distancing requirement, please remember that they may be in one Household group or their safe social circle. If someone infringes on your 2-metre (6 feet) distance, kindly remind them of the 2-metre (6 feet) rule.

Please de-escalate any confrontational situations and, if needed, report the situation to the office via text, email or phone.

### **Parental Supervision of Children**

Parents must ensure that their children maintain a 2-metre (6 feet) separation at all time from other children/people from other parties during your stay. People should wash their hands before and after using the equipment, cover all coughs and sneezes and avoid touching their face.

### **Returning from Outings**

If you leave the property for any reason, everyone in the group must wash their hands with warm water and soap (or disinfectant) for at least 20 seconds. Please consider washing your grocery and beverage packaging followed by 20 seconds of handwashing.

### **Be Kind and Supportive**

Be kind and supportive – Remember we are all in this together!

## NOTICE TO USERS OF THE PARK FACILITIES

### **Assumption of Risk and WAIVER and Release of Claims**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - These conditions will affect your legal rights.

**“Activities”** shall mean, without limitation, all activities in any way associated with or related to water sports, recreational vehicle camping, hiking, fishing and any recreational activities offered by Mountaineire Campground and RV Park, including training and instruction, as well as but not limited to use of play structures, picnic areas, fields, sports fields, beaches, lakes, man-made lakes, swimming pools, parks, trails, walking paths, roads, grounds and parking lots.

**“Property”** shall mean, without limitation, any premises, lands, buildings, facilities, play structures, fields, sports fields, beaches, lakes, man-made lakes, swimming pools, parks, trails, walking paths, roads, grounds and parking lots and equipment owned or leased by Mountaineire Campground and RV Park.

**“Park User”** shall mean all adults, children or wards in the registered parties group.

In consideration of Mountaineire Campground and RV Park allowing the **PARK USER** onto its Property to use and enjoy the Property and to participate in Activities, the **PARK USER** agrees as follows:

1. **The Park User assumes and accepts, without limitation, all risks and dangers** associated with the **PARK USER’S** use and enjoyment of the Property and participation in any of the Activities.
2. **The Park User ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY** for understanding and following the rules and safe practices associated with the use and enjoyment of the Property, participation in any of the Activities, and for his or her own personal safety.
3. **The Park User WAIVES ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** that he or she has or may have in the future against Mountaineire Campground and RV Park and its parent, subsidiaries and affiliated entities and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, contractors and assigns arising from or connected, directly or indirectly, with the **PARK USER’S** presence at, or use and enjoyment of the Property, and the **PARK USER’S** presence at, or participation in, any of the Activities.
4. **The Park User RELEASES** Mountaineire Campground and RV Park from any and all liability for any loss, damage, physical injury, illness or expense that he or she may suffer or incur by reason of his or her presence at, or use and enjoyment of, the Property, and presence at, or participation in, any of the Activities, due to any cause whatsoever, **INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER ANY APPLICABLE OCCUPIERS’ LIABILITY LEGISLATION ON THE PART OF** Mountaineire Campground and RV Park **OR OTHER PARTICIPANTS, OR ANYONE ELSE**
